
Florida has 43 Hispanic-Serving Community Colleges. These are associate granting institutions where Latinx students represent 25% or more of the total student population. An additional 26 associate granting institutions are emerging HSCCs, where Latinx students represent 15 - 24.9% of the student population.

HSCCs and Emerging HSCCs byPercent Latinx PopulationPercent Latinx Enrolled (2015)by County (2010)


